

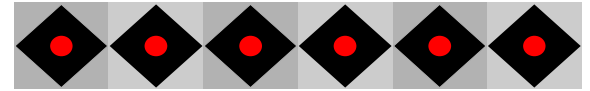
E-BiT Senior Seminar
