Please review the following criteria for the eight (8) scholarships that are awarded by the Haverhill School Committee and only apply for those scholarships in which you **meet the guidelines**. Caleb Dustin Hunking College Scholarship

Terms of the Will of the late Sarah Stone Hunking Cheney pertaining to the ***Caleb Dustin Hunking College Scholarship***:

That the City of Haverhill hereby accepts the legacy under Clause 36 of the Will of Sarah Stone Hunking Cheney consisting of one-fourth of all the rest, residue, and remainder of her estate to be held by said City of Haverhill as a separate and permanent fund for the establishing of a scholarship to be known as the “Caleb Dustin Hunking College Scholarship” and the income thereof only to be used in or toward the defraying the educational and other expenses at college, of ***some graduate of Haverhill High School***, either male or female, ***who shall also be a native and resident of Haverhill, Massachusetts***, and who may select any college or university to attend, so long as he or she shall be an ***undergraduate of good standing at such college or university***. Such scholarship shall be awarded and such income shall be expended as aforesaid, annually, if the income shall be sufficient for the purpose; otherwise as often only as the income accumulated shall be sufficient. All such awards shall be made by the School Committee of the City of Haverhill and upon the approval of the principal of the Haverhill High School, they giving in so far as possible preference to students showing the highest standard in scholarship and deportment in said high school.

(Only for students attending MIT or Business College)***

Terms of the Will of the late Sarah Stone Hunking Cheney pertaining to the ***Caleb Dustin Hunking Practical School Scholarship***:

That the City of Haverhill hereby accepts the legacy under Clause 37 of the Will of Sarah Stone Hunking Cheney consisting of one-fourth of all the rest, residue, and remainder of her estate to be held by said City of Haverhill as a separate and permanent fund for the establishing of a scholarship to be known as the "Caleb Dustin Hunking Practical School Scholarship" and the income thereof only to be used in or toward defraying the educational and other expense while attending any business college, or while attending the Massachusetts Institute of Technology at Cambridge, either male or female, ***who shall also be a native and resident of Haverhill, Massachusetts***, and who may select any business college or said Massachusetts Institute of Technology, to attend, ***so long he or she shall be an undergraduate in good standing at such business college or at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology***. Such scholarship shall be awarded, and such income shall be expended as aforesaid, annually, if the income shall be sufficient for the purpose; otherwise as often only as the income accumulated shall be sufficient. All such awards shall be made by the School Committee of the City of Haverhill and upon the approval of the principal of the Haverhill High School, they giving in so far as possible preference to students showing the highest standard in scholarship and deportment in said high school.

Terms of the Will of the late Clara Luella Hunking pertaining to the ***Clara Luella Hunking College Scholarship for Girls:***

That the City of Haverhill hereby accepts the legacy under Article Ten of the Will of Clara Luella Hunking, late of Haverhill, Massachusetts, consisting of the residue and remainder of her estate to be held as a fund, the income thereof to be used to maintain a scholarship or scholarships to enable or assist deserving and promising ***female graduates of Haverhill High School*** to attend college. Such scholarship or scholarships shall be awarded annually if the income from said fund shall be sufficient for this purpose; otherwise as often only as such income accumulated shall permit. All such scholarship awards shall be made by the School Committee of said Haverhill High School.

Terms of the Will of the late Sarah Stone Hunking Cheney pertaining to the Caleb Dustin Hunking Foreign Scholarship:

That the City of Haverhill hereby accepts the legacy under Clause 35 of the Will of Sarah Stone Hunking Cheney consisting of one-half of all the rest, residue, and remainder of her estate to be held by said City of Haverhill as a separate and permanent fund for the establishing of a scholarship to be known as the "Caleb Dustin Hunking Foreign Scholarship" and the income thereof only to be used in or toward defraying the traveling and other expenses of some graduate of ***Haverhill High School***, either male or female, ***who shall also be a native and resident of Haverhill, Massachusetts***, who shall desire to pursue his or her studies in some ***foreign*** country or countries. Such scholarship shall be awarded, and such income shall be expended as aforesaid annually, if the income shall be sufficient for the purpose; otherwise as often only as the income accumulated shall be sufficient. All such awards shall be made by the School Committee of the City of Haverhill and upon the approval of the principal of the Haverhill High School, they giving in so far as possible preference to students showing the highest standard in scholarship and deportment in said high school.

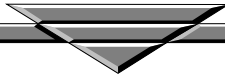

Nicholas C. Johnson Fund Award

Article Sixteenth

I give and bequeath to the City of Haverhill, a municipal corporation located in the County of Essex, Massachusetts, the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars, (\$20,000.00), to be paid to the Treasurer of the City of Haverhill, but in trust nevertheless, for the following purposes:

To establish a fund to be known as "The Nicholas C. Johnson Fund", the income thereof to be used to assist **worthy graduates of Haverhill High School** to obtain further education. The award shall be made annually, except as hereinafter provided, to one or more persons, male or female, selected by a Committee consisting of the Principal of Haverhill High School and the Superintendent of Schools of said City of Haverhill and the amount of the award allocated to each recipient shall be determined by such Committee in its discretion and such amounts need not be equal amounts. It is my wish, but not a condition or limitation on the discretion of said Committee, that, in selecting the recipients of the award, particular consideration be given to persons seeking **further education relating to the retail business** and that, in so far as is practical, each recipient of the award **receive an amount of at least Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)**. The Committee, in its discretion, may carry over to the next year funds available for the award and not in excess of **(\$500.00) Five Hundred Dollars**.

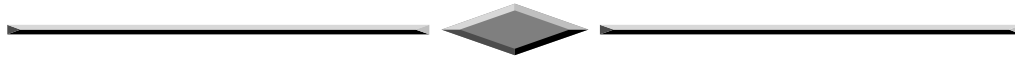
Marvin, Beatrice and Paul Brindis Scholarship Fund

Terms of the will of Beatrice Brindis pertaining to the Marvin, Beatrice and Paul Brindis Scholarship Fund

Article 2.

I give and bequeath to the SCHOOL COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF HAVERHILL, Massachusetts, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$250,000.00) Dollars. This money is to be held, kept, invested, and reinvested as a separate and permanent fund for the establishing of a scholarship fund, to be known as the "Marvin, Beatrice and Paul Brindis Scholarship Fund". Ten (10%) Percent of the net income shall be added to the principal each year. The balance of the income from said fund shall go annually toward defraying costs of tuition, and other necessary school expenses of a deserving member or members of the graduating class of Haverhill High School. Said recipient is to be determined and chosen on the basis of character and scholastic achievement and is to be selected by the Haverhill School Committee in their uncontrolled discretion.

It is the donor's wish that the income from this Trust be used to supplement other sources available to a particular student. Although need may be a consideration, a student shall not be disqualified merely because he/she or his/her family are financially able to assist in said student's tuition. If the amount of income is sufficient and if circumstances so warrant it, a full scholarship may be awarded.

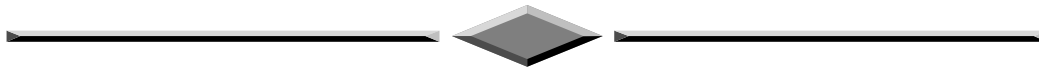

Herbert A. Chase Scholarship**

Terms of the will of the late Herbert A. Chase pertaining to the Herbert A. Chase Scholarship:

Thirty percent to the City of Haverhill, a municipal corporation existing in said Massachusetts, to provide one or more scholarships, said scholarships to be awarded at the discretion of the School Committee of the City of Haverhill under such restrictions as they may make, from time to time, with the sole purpose of aiding worthy and efficient **graduates of a public high school in Haverhill**, of either sex, to obtain a higher education than would be possible without such assistance; such education, however, to be obtained in some **duly recognized school of technology or mechanics** which admits students of every race and creed.



Samuel and Bessie Milhendler College Scholarship Fund

Each year, preferably but not necessarily upon the recommendation of the principal of Haverhill High School, the Haverhill School Committee shall award scholarship funds to one or more ***graduates of Haverhill High School who are enrolled in and attending any college or university, and who are maintaining a credible academic standing; such scholarship shall not be limited to freshman year students.*** Selection of recipients for scholarship funds to aid in defraying expenses of obtaining a college or graduate education should be based on ***need, high standard of scholarship in high school, and deportment while in said high school.***
