



## Directions for the Year Book Write-Ups

Senior write-ups are due in the next few weeks. (See the deadline list on the reverse side.) The font that will be used in the senior section of the year book is **Arial** size **10**. The maximum space works out to approximately **32** characters/spaces across and **15** lines down. You do not have to use all the available space and if you go over by a few words that's fine, this is only an approximation. We can change the font size if necessary however, if you are over by a great deal we will edit and delete as necessary. You will be emailing the finished write-up to the yearbook. Here are the directions, please read carefully:

- 1.** You must type **your name exactly as you want it to appear under your picture.**
- 2.** Press the return button. Under your name you may include a nickname. IF you include a nickname press the return button again.
- 3.** Type the message you want **exactly** as you want it to appear next to your picture. The publisher will copy **precisely** what you write. Please avoid italics and bold letters in your write-up and please don't type the entire paragraph in capital letters.
- 4.** Please **do not** skip lines or press the **return** once you start your write-up, this must be in paragraph form.
- 5.** The **subject area of the email** must contain your name and homeroom.

Make sure your message is in good taste. Some day your parents, grandparents and even children may read what you wrote.

***The yearbook advisor will make the final decision on all content and any questionable material will be deleted.***

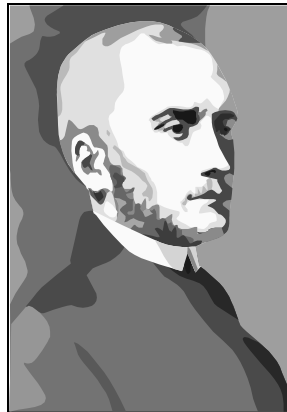
