REMINDERS /STANDARD ANNOUNCEMENTS

First period – period A – which is also homeroom - **begins at 7:25**. For the safety and security of staff and students all doors with the exception of the Main Entrance are locked after 7:25 and students will be required to enter the building through the front entrance, by the Main Office and **receive a tardy slip**. Students are **not** allowed through side or back doors at any point in the day and there will be consequences to students those open doors for them.
