REMINDERS /STANDARD ANNOUNCEMENTS

First period – period A –, which is also homeroom - **begins at 7:25**. For the safety and security of staff and students all doors with the exception of the Main Entrance are locked after 7:25 and students will be required to enter the building through the front entrance, by the Main Office and **receive a tardy slip**.
