Graduation Requirements

Mass Core is a state-recommended, rigorous program of study that aligns high school coursework with college and workforce expectations. HHS strives for all scholars currently enrolled to meet Mass Core standards. Scholars must earn a **total of 24 credits** to graduate from HHS as well as pass required state MCAS tests. Full-year courses earn 1.0 credit. Half-year courses earn 0.5 credits.

Group Level / Class Rank

Course levels at HHS have been assigned to one of four group levels. Each group level is then assigned a group level value which is used in calculating quality points.

Class rank at Haverhill High School is weighted and determined by a quality point calculation. To calculate quality points one must multiply the grade point value by the weight of the group to which the course is assigned. The quality points are then

divided by the total credits attempted to determine a Quality Point Average (QPA).

Grade Point Average (GPA)

GPA at Haverhill High School <u>is unweighted</u>. This means GPA is a straight average of a scholar's final grades in all courses taken over the span of his/her high school career based on the earned GPA value for each course.
